



LIITO – International Business Training for Female Entrepreneurs

LIITO is a training and development project aimed at improving the level of competence as well as the readiness to internationalize among the personnel in small and medium size companies operating in the Lahti Region.

The project is managed by Lahti University of Applied Sciences' Innovation Centre and runs from October 1st 2004 till December 31st 2007 with its main objective set at improving the readiness of the company staff members involved in the training programme to act in a multi-cultural working environment together with offering the enterprises opportunities to international cooperation and networking. Other objectives include developing the international female entrepreneurs' exchange activities in order to develop new connections and cooperation between the entrepreneurs.

Member enterprises will be able to activate and improve their operating sector related language skills, establish new international contacts to support their business activities as well as to work in an internationalizing and multi-cultural environment and to see and experience international impressions prevailing in their sector. The training also develops the participants' social qualities and communication skills.

LIITO is co-funded by the European Social Fund, Labour Market Department of the Employment and Economic Development Centre for Häme and the City of Lahti.

The project is looking for foreign partners from European countries in order to develop entrepreneur exchanges and to create together a new way of cooperation for female entrepreneurs internationalization.
